 - The bidder has completed contract in the total cumulative amount equal to at least US\$ 162,000.00 equal to at least two times value of the subject contract in the preceding two years.
 - The Bidder has availability of liquid assets through either: (i) access to a line of credit or cash in bank account of an amount at least US\$ 40,500.00 of subject contract, net of other contractual commitment; or credit terms with vendors specifically for the goods to be supplied under the contract, and valid for at least 6 months after the deadline date for submission of bids specified in ITB Clause 21.
