The GIZ MUSEFO supports the Department of Maternal and Child Health Center of the Ministry of Health (MoH) to develop nutrition counseling apps for health center staff, Village health support group members (VHGS), and self-counselling of pregnant and lactating women and caregivers of children under 2 years of age nationwide. The current apps were developed using the Android platform. However, a need to transform these app (coding) from Android to iOS platform . Therefore, GIZ MUSEFO is seeking a National Consultant or local firm to performs the app conversation. The successor is expected to start from Mid of June and end at the end of November 2024. They are expected to travel to the field for user acceptance testing.

The detail services/ works are described in the enclosed Terms of Reference (ToR).

If more than one offer is received from a bidder in response to a tender, only the most recently submitted offer will be considered. ***Please note that in case consultant did not registered VAT. GIZ will deduct 15% Withholding Tax from consultant fee.***

The default size of e-mails is limited to 30 MB. Above that, GIZ's email servers refuse the message and its attachments. If necessary, send more than one e-mail.

Non-compliance may result in your bid not being considered.

The bids received shall be evaluated by GIZ regarding their technical content (**70%**) and by their commercial aspects (**30%**) whereupon the bidders shall be ranked. Contractual negotiations are generally commenced with the first bidder on the list. Should these negotiations not be successful, the second bidder on the list shall be invited to commence negotiations.
